

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APOPKA, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2019 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2020, PROVIDING FOR A BUDGET AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Apopka, Florida, has determined that the Budget for Fiscal Year 2019/2020 should be amended; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes, Section 166.241(4) requires the governing body amend the budgets in the same manner as the original budget is adopted; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the final budgets for fiscal year 2019/2020 through resolution on September 18, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APOPKA, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the Budget for the City of Apopka, Florida, and Fiscal Year 2019/2020 is hereby amended for an amount totaling \$30,000 as indicated in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and made part of this Resolution by reference.

SECTION 2: Effective Date. This Resolution shall take effect upon final passage and adoption.

<p>This budget amendment includes changes in funding and appropriations related to the award of the Recycling Anti-Contamination grant being received by a private source from theThe Recycling Partnership. The award is in the amount of \$15,000 with a \$15,000 City match being utilized from the Sanitation fund reserves. The objective is to support residential behavior resulting in improved recycling quality. This project will involve the mailing of information on the City's recycling program, curbside inspections, and tagging of residential recycling carts. Information mailers will be processed internally and an outside printing source will be utilized for producing the cart tags. The City will piggyback off of Orange County's contract with MidAtlantic Solid Waste Consultants, LLC (MSW).</p>
